## iscussion

Read Romans 8:26,27. How can a Christian pray according to God's will?

### iblical Insight

How important is it to pray according to God's will? Extremely! Too many believers claim all of God's promises for answered prayer, but overlook this condition. Jesus, God's own Son, demonstrated the need to surrender to God in prayer (Luke 22:39-44). Jesus was praying about the "cup" (experience of suffering) that He was soon to endure. This cup was more than just the agony of suffering the pain of the Cross; it was also the most horrible of all pains, separation from the Father. During those dark three hours when the world shook,

> the sky was darkened, and the anger of the world was cast upon Him, Christ's own Father turned away from Him while He (Christ) became sin for us. This was the greatest pain to be suffered by anyone, greater than an eternity spent in hell. Christ asked that if possible this cup, this separation, would not happen, yet He knew He must endure it so that we could have eternal life.

Don't go to the next section yet. Before continuing, think about what Jesus did for us on the Cross.
