Game Time - Week 13

For this week's game time we are going to participate in an activity that was very popular in school many years ago: *Show & Tell*. Show & Tell is an activity where each person chooses something that is important to them, shows it to the group, and then tells about it. Examples could include a piece of equipment for a sport you like to play, a Lego project you built, a book you're reading, or a puppet you like to use to entertain others – anything that is interesting to you for some reason.

As you do this with your group, you will learn new things about others, and they'll learn new things about you. It is always fun to learn new things about each other. You may discover that you already share an interest with someone in a way you were never aware of, such as you both play soccer or you both like to read books.

Learning about others and helping them to learn about us is a good way to build friendship and show people that they are important to us. We're all different. We have different interests and skills. We may look different, dress differently, or have different ethnic or racial backgrounds. But every person is important. Every person matters. And when we take an interest in the things that matter to others, we show them that they matter to us. Use this as an opportunity to show the other guys in your group that they are important to you and anything that matters to them, matters to you.

Chose something from around your house that has some importance to you and then tell your group what is special about it. Pay close attention while others are sharing their interests and see how many things you have in common.
