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READ

Listen, my sons, to a father's instruction; pay attention and gain understanding. I give you sound learning, so do not forsake my teaching. When I was a boy in my father's house, still tender, and an only child of my mother, he taught me and said, "Lay hold of my words with all your heart; keep my commands and you will live. Get wisdom, get understanding; do not forget my words or swerve from them. Proverbs 4:1–5

What is the most recent piece of advice you have received from your dad or a major male role model? What did he say? How did you take it? There is something very important about a father or father figure's words to his son. A godly man will speak words that are wise and that should be followed. Unfortunately, the world we live in has too few dads who are following God and speaking words of wisdom to their sons.

Godly men should take time to speak to and teach their sons how men should behave. Have you and your dad ever talked about work, how men should treat women, how to be a good friend, or how to live? You may have a godly dad who has spent time with you teaching you these things, but many young men grow up without that. Thank the Lord for great Royal Rangers leaders who can act as a father figure at times. If you are privileged to have a godly dad, your job as a son is to listen to his teaching and wisdom, and to learn from it. Nobody is perfect, even your dad, but he undoubtedly has a ton of amazing things to teach you. Take note of the things he has taught you about life, family, and work. Also remember that dads don't just teach you by what they say, but by what they do too.

If you are not in a home with a godly dad, then you can find a godly man and allow him to teach you these things. Your church is full of godly men who can teach you how a man who follows God should live.

You need to learn how to honor, respect, and obey your dad, even if he is not a godly man. You can be a great witness and example to him by demonstrating a life of Christian excellence. Honor your dad, love your dad, and pray that he will become a godly man.

No matter how old you get, you will never reach a place in life that you don't need godly men to mentor you and give you wisdom. Even pastors, presidents, and principals have mentors they look to and learn from. A smart man will not only have mentors, but also a group of men relatively close to his age that he can relate to and share experiences with. As godly men, we need to lean on other godly men for support as we follow God's plan. **PRAYER:** God, thank You for the godly male influences in my life. I thank You for the godly things I have learned from them. Help me to be a good son, to listen, to learn, and to apply the wisdom shown to me. Help me to live with integrity and respect before my dad every day. In Jesus' name. Amen.
