

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:1-4

There is a joke about a man who called technical support. His computer would not come on. The support person had the man try different key commands. The support person had the man check the cords that connect to the computer. The support person tried every trick he knew.

Still, the man's computer wouldn't start up. Then, the support person asked if the power strip was working properly. All of a sudden, the computer owner knew what was wrong. His computer was not plugged in to the power strip.
