Frontier Rifleman Merit Requirements checklist

INTRODUCTION

The Frontier Rifleman merit is a part of the Arrowhead merit series developed by the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship (FCF). Although Arrowhead merits are intended to provide FCF members with specialized training on advanced frontier skills, any Royal Rangers boy may earn an Arrowhead merit and any Royal Rangers leader may teach an Arrowhead merit regardless of FCF membership status. As with any merit, the boy's group leader approves the completion of all Arrowhead merits.

Boys seeking to earn this skill merit or adult leaders seeking to earn the related Arrowhead award must accumulate a minimum of 15 points from any combination of the following requirements. For information on Arrowhead merits and Arrowhead awards, refer to the *Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship Handbook* (2014 edition).

MERIT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Complete a basic black powder certification course sponsored by NMLRA or NRA. (1 point)
- 2. Build a functional muzzle-loading rifle from scratch or from a kit. The finished rifle must include a formed, inlet and finished stock, lock mechanism, trigger, barrel, sights, and ramrod. (3 points)
- 3. Pour and mold one hundred round balls at the size (caliber) that is appropriate for your rifle. (1 point)
- 4. Place ten two-inch-wide wood stakes at fifty yards. Hit six out of ten stakes at fifty yards (ten shots total). (2 points)
