Merit Requirements



The following merit requirements must be successfully completed for a boy to be awarded the official Royal Rangers Family Gamer merit. Content relating to each requirement may be found in the next section of this guide.

- 1. Explain the importance of good sportsmanship and following the rules when playing games.
- 2. Discuss how to choose games that are age appropriate and free from objectionable content.
- 3. Discuss the importance of balancing playing time with other activities and responsibilities in life.
- 4. Play at least (1) game from each of the following categories with your family or group:
 - a. Board game
 - b. Card game
 - c. Strategy game
 - d. Video game (may include computer games or smartphone apps)
 - e. Backyard or party game
 - f. Role-playing games or simulations
- 5. Do (1) of the following:
 - a. Attend or participate in a gaming club event or tournament.
 - b. Research and describe the origins of a popular game, explaining who created it, how it was developed, and how it may have changed over time.
 - c. Modify the rules of an existing game to make it playable for a different age group, language, or ability level.
 - d. Read a book or website that has tips for how to become a better player at your favorite game.
 - e. Host a family game night for your church or outpost, inviting members of the community to attend.
- 6. Create a simple game for 1–4 players. Make or gather all necessary game pieces or equipment. Explain the rules and how to play. Then, play the game with your family or group.
