Merit Requirements Checklist

Each requirement must be approved by the boy's group leader or his designee. 2.	Explain the four components of firing a shot. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Sight alignment b. Breath control c. Trigger squeeze d. Follow-through 	
3.	Complete an exercise to identify your dominant eye.	
4.	Explain and demonstrate the three-person shooting team process— loader, shooter, and spotter.	
5.	Demonstrate how to sight in an air rifle on a shooting range.	
6.	Demonstrate the proper use of a rifle sling.	
7.	Demonstrate and shoot from each of the following shooting positions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Bench rest b. Standing c. Kneeling d. Sitting e. Prone 	
8.	Demonstrate how to score a paper target using a scoring gauge.
