MERIT REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

INTRODUCTION

The Frontier Preacher Merit is a part of the Arrowhead merit series developed by the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship (FCF). Although Arrowhead merits are intended to provide FCF members with specialized training on advanced frontier skills, any Royal Rangers boy may earn an Arrowhead merit and any Royal Rangers leader may teach an Arrowhead merit regardless of FCF membership status. As with any merit, the boy's group leader approves the completion of all Arrowhead merits.

Boys seeking to earn this skill merit or adult leaders seeking to earn the related Arrowhead award must accumulate a minimum of 15 points from any combination of the following requirements. For information on Arrowhead merits and Arrowhead awards, refer to the *Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship Handbook* (2014 edition).

MERIT REQUIREMENTS

- Research the history of two circuit riding preachers. Write a three hundredword essay on each preacher, detailing personal history and accomplishments. In each essay, explain how the circuit riding preacher was able to spread the gospel. (1 point)
- 2. Research and assemble a circuit riding preacher's outfit. Wear the outfit at a Royal Rangers or FCF event. (3 points)
- 3. Assist your outpost chaplain for six months. (3 points)
- 4. Develop and conduct an age-specific devotion for each Royal Rangers age group (Ranger Kids, Discovery Rangers, Adventure Rangers, and Expedition Rangers) at your local outpost. (2 points)
