Merit Requirements Checklist

The following merit requirements must be successfully completed for a boy to be awarded the official Royal Rangers green Air Rifle merit award. Each requirement must be approved by the boy's Group Leader or his designee.

1.	Complete all requirements for the Air Gun Safety merit.	
2.	Participate in a shooting event according to the following standards. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Air Gun: any sporter air rifle weighing 7.5 pounds or less b. Ammunition: .177 caliber skirted pellets c. Targets: AR-5 targets only d. Distance: 10 meters from shooting line to target line e. Rules: official NRA Sporter Air Rifle Rules f. Positions: prone or bench rest positions only 	
3.	Score a minimum of (15) points on each of (10) bullseyes, shooting (5) shots on each.	
4.	Answer the following questions concerning air rifle shooting. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. When did air rifle shooting become an Olympic event? b. What shooting position is used in this event? c. What shooting distance is used? d. What size is the 10 ring in the bulls eye?
