 - b. Birdie
 - c. Eagle
 - d. Bogey
 - e. Ace

- g. Rough
- h. Hazard
- i. Line of play
- j. Mandatory route
- 7. Demonstrate your ability to make disc throws using at least (2) different throwing methods.
- 8. Complete at least (2) rounds of (9) holes of disc golf on (2) different courses with someone in your group keeping score.
- 9. Describe the differences between at least (2) disc golf courses you have played on, explaining which was most challenging and why.
