7.	Describe a common use for each of the following knots. Then	
	demonstrate your ability to tie each of them:	
	a. Figure eight	
	b. Square knot	
	c. Clove hitch	
	d. Sheet bend	
	e. Bowline	
	f. Two half hitches	
	g. Taut line hitch	
	h. Trucker's hitch
